In October 2023 the A9/A904 project team hosted the a 'Fair Work' meet the buyer event. This was delivered in partnership with Falkirk Council, Business Gateway, Supplier Development Programme and the Supply Chain Sustainability School.

A first of its kind for the partners, this event thematically focus on highlighting the challenges faced tackling modern slavery and the importance of ensuring fair working practices for all within our industry.

Balfour Beatty presented on their commitments to tackle modern slavery, signposting local and SME suppliers to resources, and discussing what steps we are taking to ensure fair working practices within our supply chain.

As part of the SCAPE Gen 3 Framework, Regional Scotland are holding labour practise audits, through external stakeholder Achilles. Two have already been delivered in 2023, with more to come in 2024.
